## \*\*\* WORKSHOP 1: DEEPENING YOUR MARRIAGE CONNECTION

<u>Married (and Engaged) Couples</u> – Through individual work, private couple discussion and practice time, small groups, and large group discussion, we will experience these subjects together: The purpose of marriage; creating oneness and friendship; increasing physical and spiritual unity; building couple consultation skills; strengthening character; and managing time and service choices. Couples will receive the books *Pure Gold: Encouraging Character Qualities in Marriage* and *Deciding in Unity*. (Note: Sessions are enrichment for healthy married couples, not those in crisis.)

Cost for Workshop 1: The workshop is free. There will be a \$15.00 fee per couple for materials.

## \*\*\* WORKSHOP 2: EXPLORING & UNDERSTANDING RELATIONSHIPS AND MARRIAGE

"Careful preparation for marriage is an essential first step in the preservation of Bahá'í marriage." (Bahá'í World Centre Research Dept.)

Sunday, May 11, 2014: 1:30-5:30 p.m. (On-site registration begins at 1:00 p.m.)

<u>Unmarried Individuals Ages 18 to 35</u> – Being in a relationship and thinking about marriage takes confidence, courage, and commitment. Topics will include: Why marry and what to expect; being a couple: dating, courting, and chastity; how can you really know someone's character; living a life of service; and an interactive married couple panel. Individuals will receive *Marriage Can Be Forever—Preparation Counts!*.

Cost for Workshop 2: The workshop is free. There will be a \$15.00 fee per person for materials.

**Please Note:** These are participatory, knowledge and skill-building, and fun sessions. They are educational, not therapy. Sessions will include the Bahá'í Writings and be primarily focused for Bahá'ís; people of any faith are welcome.
